My field ecology students surveyed Caretaker's Woods in early June and early September of 2005 using the Curtis-Cottom Quarter-Point method. In the June survey we did not get the boundaries quite right, so I had another group re-do the survey in the fall. Approximately 25 students participated in the two surveys.
