**FP&M staff recommendation for F. H. King permit request for additional land:*

The permit request to expand lands for use by F. H. King from .96 acres to 2.0 acres should be denied. All areas in the general vicinity of the current FH King plots are currently permitted to other groups, with the exception of the drainage swale immediately to the north. This swale area may be needed for future water quality management improvement and therefore should not be allocated for other permitted uses.

F. H. King has an opportunity to review their current management practices and thereby attempt to get more out of the area they are currently farming. This request could be reconsidered in future years--if land becomes available from other permitted users.
