Lakeshore Nature Preserve Volunteer Work Party Meeting Places



Picnic Point parking lot 129 (2000 University Bay Dr.): On University Bay Drive and the Lakeshore Path; next to the stone wall. On the free Route 80 bus route. Bike racks available. Park for free on weekends. Weekday volunteers can request a free parking permit from the Volunteer Coordinator.

Class of 1918 Marsh lot 130 (2001 University Bay Dr.): On University Bay Drive in the "circle" parking lot. On the free Route 80 bus route. Bike racks available. Park for free on weekends. Weekday volunteers can request a free parking permit from the Volunteer Coordinator.

Frautschi Point parking lot (3034 Lake Mendota Dr.): On Lake Mendota Drive where the road takes a sharp turn from north/south to east/west. On the free Route 80 bus route. The bus drives west through Eagle Heights Apartment complex before turning east on Lake Mendota Drive. The bus will drive past the Frautschi Point parking lot. Get off at the next stop—"Lot R"; then walk back to Frautschi Point parking lot. Bike racks available.

Raymer's Cove parking lot: On Lake Mendota Drive; north of the Eagle Heights Apartment complex. On the free Route 80 bus route. The Bus drives west through Eagle Heights Apartment complex before turning east on Lake Mendota Drive. The bus will drive past the Raymer's Cove parking lot. Get off at the next stop—"Lot N"; then walk back to Raymer's Cove parking lot.



Eagle Heights Woods:

<u>Entrance A</u>: Trailhead at the intersection of Lake Mendota Drive and Eagle Heights Drive. On the free Route 80 bus route. The Bus drives west through Eagle Heights Apartment complex. Get off at stop—"Lot M"; then walk to the trailhead at the intersection. Bike racks available.

Entrance B: Trailhead at the end of Shady Lane. Park on Wood Lane and walk to the trailhead. Bike racks available.



Willow Creek Woods: Located north of the Natatorium and west of Dejope Hall; adjacent to Lakeshore Path. Free parking available on weekends in Lot 57 (632 Willow Drive) behind the Natatorium. On the free Route 80 bus route.

On Lakeshore Path behind Tripp Hall: Follow Lakeshore Path to Tripp Hall or take Observatory Drive to north on Babcock Drive to parking lot 34. On the free Route 80 bus route.

Muir Knoll (next to Gard Memorial Storytellers Circle): On Observatory Drive just west of Helen C. White Hall and north of Bascom Hall. Park in lot 34 (1480 Tripp Circle) then walk east on Lakeshore Path to the Preserve kiosk; take steps up to Muir Knoll. On the free Route 80 bus route.
